ORDINANCE FOR THE REZONE OF LAND IN TOWN OF SUMNER

ORDINANCE

REZONE OF A PARCEL IN THE TOWN OF SUMNER

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Trempealeau does ordain as follows:

The zoning districts for Trempealeau County and zoning map shall be amended to show that the following described real estate is rezoned from Residential 20 (R-20) to Commercial (C).

A parcel of land further described as:

Part of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, Volume 7, Certified Survey Map 256, Lot 1, Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 07 West, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin

Containing approximately 1.64 acres.
