Meeting called to order at 9:02 a.m. by Frey stating proper posting and notification has met open meeting requirements. Frey informed the committee the approval for the agenda posted is not required and will be eliminated as any changes made must be posted 24 hours in advance of the scheduled meeting time.

Motion by Frey and seconded by Miller to approve the September 22, 2016 meeting minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

Discussion of Monthly Issues and Concerns in Department & Jail

2017 Budget – Sheriff went over the proposed 2017 budget and the request for an additional position in order to inform the newly added committee member, Richard Sacia. Sheriff advised he hopes the Committee realizes the importance of this position and would like to be supported in order to aid in the fight of the increase in drugs in this county.

Dispatch Center – Frye advised that the ADRC department will be relocated across the street which will allow the Dispatch Center and Emergency Management Coordinator’s Office to relocate out of the basement into the space currently being occupied by ADRC. A contract is being written up to present to Executive Finance for approval and then move to the full Board for their approval. The State will be paying for 83 percent of the ADRC building remodel to bring up to code.

Discussion of General Operations

Currently researching the option of purchasing a body x-ray machine for the Jail. This is informational at this time.

Jeremy Matheny is still working on revamping the table edges in the Jail. Trying to find a local vendor that would be able to complete the task at a cost less expensive to the county. There is a sliding door in the Jail that no longer operates electronically and must be manually opened with a key. Cameras in need of repair in the Jail will be taken care of in November.

One of the Sheriff’s Office squads engine needed replaced with a cost of \$5,640.00.
