Minutes from September 11, 2014, Committee Meeting

Committee Members Present: Michael Nelson, Richard Frey, Tim Zeglin.

Agenda Item #1--Meeting convened at 9:06 AM by Richard Frey as chairperson.

Twenty-five (25) ordinances listed on the original six-page handout were reviewed, discussed, and recommended or not recommended by committee. Outcome of discussion is recorded below.

06/2000 (Resolution relating to collection of fines, forfeitures, etc.) ---suggest for repeal.

08/1982 (Ordinance prohibiting filing of wills, etc.)---suggest to retain.

10/1973 (Community mental health retardation, etc.)---repeal.

11/2011 (Carrying of Concealed Weapons, etc.)---retain.

01/2002 (Prohibit tobacco use, etc.)---modify and incorporate into 03/1994 ordinance.

03/1994 (Prohibit Tobacco in courthouse and jail)---retain with modifications as per above

03/1993 (Prohibit smoking in courthouse)---repeal.

02/1986 (Use of county-owned vehicles)---review by department heads. Radtke will check for compliance with Garcia Act, return to committee at future meeting.

11/1985 (Loitering in Courthouse) --- repeal.

09/2002 (Truancy Ordinance Revision)---retain.

02/1998 (Revised Truancy Ordinance) ---repeal.

12/1994 (Truancy Ordinance) --- repeal.

05/1983 (Public Records) --- repeal

05/1976 (Beekeeping Ordinance) --- investigate and reconsider at future meeting

04/1970 (Civil Defense) --- already repealed

11/1967 (Civil Defense) ---already repealed

11/1966 (Civil Defense Committee) --- already repealed

11/1962 (Provide Authorization . . . to participate in Civil Defense Program, etc.) --- already repealed

06/1962 (Amend Civil Defense Ordinance) --- already repealed

11/1961 (. . . Ordinance creating . . . Department of Public Welfare, etc.) ---already repealed

11/1956 (Civil Defense) --- already repealed.

11/1956 (Civil Defense-Welfare Services) --- already repealed.

11/1955 (County Dept. of Public Welfare) --- already repealed.

11/2004 (Revise Emergency Management Ordinance) --- **This repealed the previous eight ordinances on the list.** This ordinance needs revision; Radtke will bring up revisions to Law enforcement Committee; will bring up for consideration by this committee at future meeting.

04/1995 (Uniform Numbering System Ordinance) --- Radtke currently working on revised ordinance that will repeal this ordinance.

09/2012 (Amend Sale of Tax Deeded Land) --- retain.

02/2007 (Ordinance Limiting Claims for Damages by Dogs) --- retain.

Discussion/decision on future meeting

Radtke will select block of remaining ordinances to be review in two hour period at next meeting.

Radtke will e-mail selected ordinances to Frey and send paper copies to Nelson and Zeglin. Committee will attempt to review this block and reach recommendations on all ordinances in the block at October committee meeting. Both blocks of ordinances (August and September) will be brought before full Board for consideration at September full board meeting. Committee will tentatively meet on 2nd Thursday of each month until all ordinances and resolutions have been reviewed and recommendation reached for all ordinances
