05/1976 Beekeeping Ordinance, referred to UW-Extension Committee

11/1962 Emergency Management, referred to Law Enforcement Committee

05/1983 Public Records, needs updates, referred to District Attorney, then to Exec/Finance Committee

Committee review, discussion, and recommendations for selected ordinances

Twenty-five (25) ordinances listed on the original six-page handout were reviewed, discussed, and recommended or not recommended by committee. Outcome of discussion is recorded below.

03/2011 (T.C. Human Health Hazard Ordinance) ---suggest to retain as is.

01/2004 (T.C. Environmental Health and Sanitation Ordinance)---referred to Board of Health.

01/2004 (T.C. Permit and Inspection Fees . . .)---referred to Board of Health. .

10/2003 (T.C. Human Health Hazard Ordinance)---repealed as of 03/2011

03/2003 (T.C. Private Water Systems Ordinance)---retain, but should be moved to Zoning Dept. and needs some language updating.

03/2000 (Citation Ordinance for Human health Hazards . . .)---needs some language changes, ask BOH to review page 7.

03/2000 (Amendment to Health and Sanitation Ordinance)---already repealed by 01/2004.

01/2000 (Environmental Health and Sanitation Ordinance)—already repealed by 01/2004.

01/2000 (Health and Sanitation Inspection Fees ordinance)---already repealed by 01/2004.

10/1996 (T.C. Human health Hazard Ordinance) ---suggest for repeal.

09/1973 (Community Mental Health Mental Retardation, . . .)---suggest for repeal.

11/1969 (West Central Mental Health Clinic Ordinance) –was a resolution only, no need for action.

09/1968 (Amend West Central . . .)—suggest for repeal.

11/1967 (Ordinance Creating West Central . . .)---suggest for repeal.

05/1989 (Five Trustees)—refer to Exec/Finance Committee; does Health Center Board now need to include member of Ag Committee?

01/2012 (Amend ATV Ordinance)—retain as is.

11/2010 (ATV Ordinance)—suggest for repeal.

10/2001 (Create 4 year term for Hwy. Commissioner, amended to “indefinite . . .)---ordinance includes four papers, 4 year resolution was signed, then amended---suggest to retain as is.

02/1998 (Ordinance Prohibiting Tobacco use . . .)---not an ordinance, should not be on list for ad hoc committee to consider.

10/1976 (Traffic ordinance Amendment in Hale)---Radtke will review, probably repealed by 01/1980 Ordinances.

07/1976 (Traffic Ordinances Amendment in Ettrick)—Radtke will review, ditto above.

09/1957 (Ordinance to Regulate Traffic)—Radtke will review, ditto above.

02/1954 (Highway Traffic Ordinance)—already repealed.

11/1949 (“ “ “) “ “
