09/1994 Trespass Ordinance 94-03. Amended by Trespass Ordinance 96-02

09/1994 Citation Ordinance 94/05. Recommended for repeal, because it applies only and specifically to 94-03, which is no longer in effect because it was amended by 96-02.

02/1994 Ordinance Regarding Prisoner Reimbursement. Recommended for repeal because 2012 remains in place and 2012 was never repealed.

07/1993 Financing 911 Emergency Telephone. Referred to Law enforcement for statutory checking.

08/1989 Underage Alcohol Consumption Ordinance. Referred to Law Enforcement for thorough review. Question of fake IDs is a policy decision—how strict should county be? No change in ordinance since 1989.

04/1982 New Ordinance Concerning Alcohol Use by Minors. Already repealed by 08/1989; should be dropped from listing.

04/1982 Ordinance to Regulate Large Gatherings. Referred to Exec/Finance Committee for decision as to whether or not repeal. This ordinance repeals 07/1972, 06/1972, 07/1970, 06/2008.

09/1980 Ordinance Prohibiting Trespass, etc. Recommended for repeal. Was amended by 1984 but not formally repealed.

01/1980 Ordinance to Revise and Update Traffic Regulations. Skipped for now; will consider again after review by Hwy. Dept.

10/1976 TC Traffic Ordinance Amendment. Skip for now, review by Hwy. Dept.

07/1976 Disorderly Conduct Ordinance. Referred to Law Enforcement Committee. Content should be reviewed; needs deposit schedule.

07/1976 TC Traffic Ordinance Amendment. Skip for now, review by Hwy. Dept.

02/1974 Traffic Ordinance Amendment-55 mph. Skip for now, review by Hwy. Dept.

11/1972 Traffic Ordinance. Skip for now, review by Hwy. Dept.

07/1972 Changes in Rock Festival Ordinance. Already repealed by 04/1982.

06/1972 Amend Rock Festival Ordinance. Already repealed by 04/1982.

07/1970 Rock Festival Ordinance. Already repealed by 04/1982.

06/1969 Traffic ordinance. Already repealed; drop from list.

02/1972 TC Traffic Ordinance Amendment. Already repealed; drop from list.

02/1967 Amend TC Traffic Ordinance. Already repealed; drop from list.

06/2007 Ordinance Regarding Management and Use of Parks. Referred to Parks Committee. Needs deposit schedule; check for accuracy.
