Minutes from January 22, 2015, Committee Meeting

Committee Members Present: Michael Nelson, Richard Frey, Tim Zeglin.

Others Present: Rian Radtke (Corporate Counsel)

Agenda Item #1--Meeting convened at 9:03 AM by Richard Frey as chairperson. Frey certifies compliance with open meeting laws.

Agenda Item #2--Motion to adopt today's agenda made by Nelson; 2nd by Zeglin; all in favor.

Agenda Item #3--Motion to adopt minutes of last meeting made by Nelson; 2nd by Zeglin; all in favor.

Agenda Item #4--Committee review, discussion, and recommendations for selected ordinances

Radtke reported on status of various ordinances that have been referred to various committees:

Four (4) ordinances have been referred to Board of Health; Radtke is working on these with Megan Speedman, results still pending;

Beekeeping Ordinance has been repealed by full County Board;

Various speed limit ordinances have been referred to Highway Dept., Dave Lyga is working on them; results still pending;

Records Retention Ordinance was referred to Sheriff's Dept. for opinion; Radtke sent e-mail to Carol; Radtke has received no answer;

Law enforcement ordinances are in front of L. E. Comm., Radtke will change these or add deposit schedules as directed; results still pending;

911 Funding ordinance; still under consideration by Bill Schreiner;

Ordinance to Regulate Large Gatherings; Radtke has prepared revisions, revised ordinance will appear on agenda of next Exec/Finance Comm. meeting;

Parks Ordinance; committee is considering changes and will return opinions; results still pending.

The following ordinances were reviewed and discussed for the first time at this meeting. Thirteen (13) ordinances listed on the original six-page handout/master list were reviewed, discussed, and recommended or not recommended by committee. Outcome of discussion is recorded below.

12/1998 Ordinance Changing name of "Agency on Aging", 05/1993 Create Commission on Aging, 05/1979 Ordinance Creating a County Agency on Aging--Radtke recommends sending these three to Human Services Dept. in order to update names and to clarify authority.

02/1994 Ordinance for County Commission on Aging, etc.--Radtke reports that this ordinance was repealed by 1979 ordinance.

09/2006 Ordinance Regarding Appraisal of Tax Foreclosed Real Estate--Radtke describes "in rem" process that controls this ordinance; Radtke recommends updating this ordinance to conform with 2012 Amendment Ordinance.

09/1989 Sale of Tax Deeded Lands--Radtke recommends sending this to Exec/Finance Committee for two minor changes ("79.35" should be "75.35" and "Finance" should be "Exec/Finance").

07/2005 Local Sales Tax Continuation ordinance--Radtke recommends referral to Exec/Finance Comm.

09/1994 Bad Check Ordinance--Radtke recommends referral to Law Enforcement Committee; this ordinance governs a law violation, not a treasurer's decision;

09/1992 Ordinance Providing for Return of Tax Deeded Real Estate--Radtke recommends referral to Exec/Finance Comm. for wording changes on page 2.

10/1983 Ordinance Electing to Proceed under Section 75.521 etc.--Radtke recommends retention as is.

09/1983 Create a Section of the County Code of Ordinances Relating to Implementing a Penalty etc.--this has already been repealed.

06/1978 Delinquent Tax Collection Ordinance--this has already been repealed.

04/1948 Tax Deed Acquisition and Repeal--Radtke recommends for repeal

Agenda Item #5—Refer Ordinances to next County Board Meeting
