

Trempealeau County Personnel/Bargaining Meeting

Meeting called to order by Chairman Dick Miller at 8:00 AM in the Trempleo Room at the Trempealeau County Government Center, Whitehall, Wisconsin on Monday, April 1st, 2013.

Committee Members Present: Dick Miller, Doug Winters, Ernie Vold, Tom Bice

Notice was posted according to open meeting law requirements.

Adoption of the Agenda – **M/2nd by Bice/Winters to adopt the agenda; Motion carried.**

Approval of minutes from previous meetings (3/21/2013) – **M/2nd by Winters/Vold to approve minutes; Motion carried.**

Committee discussed possible proposals to bring to the joint P/B & E/F committee meeting. Much discussion was had regarding what to propose. **M/2nd by Winters/Vold to propose \$0.50 per hour increase to the Non-Union employees covered by the Salary Administration Policy. The motion was amended by Miller/Vold to add 1% to the current table, then \$0.50 per hour, effective 1/1/2013. Motion Carried, amendment to the motion passed. Vote was taken on the amended motion. Motion carried.**

Kabus advised that Corporation Counsel compensation is based off of a resolution and is not included in the Non-Union Salary grid. Discussion was had as to including this position on the grid. This would create a new grade on the grid. **M/2nd by Miller/Vold to include the Corporation Counsel position onto the Non-Union salary grid and make part of the non-union employees covered by the Salary Administration Policy as approved above. Motion Carried.**

The Committee also addressed the resolution that establishes the Part-Time, Fill-in, Occasional, Seasonal and other Non-Represented positions. Discussion was had as to what positions this included and the number of people this includes. **M/2nd by Miller/Winters to increase this group by \$0.40 per hour. M/2nd by Bice/Vold to amend the motion to \$0.50 per hour increase effective the first full payroll after approval. Motion Carried, amendment approved. Motion Carried, amended motion approved.**
