What can the Health Department do for you?

WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (WIC)

WIC Nutrition services to pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women and children under 5

Maternal Child Health/Prenatal Care Home visits and education are provided to pregnant women and families

Immunizations Childhood immunizations (Free for children without insurance)



Childhood Lead Program Blood lead screening for children ages 1-5

Car Seat Program Car safety tips and assistance are available. Car seats available at the health department for purchase.

Children with Special Health Care Needs This program offers free confidential information and referrals for services to children with special health care needs from birth to 21 years of age. Information includes recommendations for books, articles, audio visuals, and websites related to your child's special needs

ADULT SERVICES

Home Care Health assessment, wound care, medication set up, bathing and nail care.

Wisconsin Well Woman Program An income-based program for women ages 45-64. It covers clinical breast exam and pap smear with pelvic exam for women ages 45-64 years of age and mammography for women 50-64 years of age.

Communicable Disease Investigation Follow-up of communicable diseases reportable in the state of Wisconsin. Includes: blood-borne illness, sexually transmitted infections, tick-borne, waterborne illness, and foodborne illness

Shining Smiles- Oral health program for pregnant women and children under 10 years of age who have Medicaid coverage. It offers: preliminary oral examination, education, 3 fluoride varnish applications per year
