

# TREMPEALEAU COUNTY INSPECTION LIST

*THE WORK YOU ARE DOING MUST BE INSPECTED, CALL BEFORE COVERING IT UP*

*IF COMPLETED WORK IS NOT CALLED IN, IT WILL BE FAILED AND MAY BE REQUIRED TO BE REMOVED OR UNCOVERED!*

POST PERMIT ON SITE BEFORE YOU START TO DIG AND KEEP PLAN ON SITE

1. **Notify Dept. of Land Management 24 hours prior to land disturbance**
2. **Temporary electric service, before power can be turned on (where required)**
3. **Footings, FORMED with bleeders installed before pouring**  
(Frost walls may not require bleeders)
4. **Foundation, with drain tile and stone installed before backfilling**  
(Slab on grade formed prior to pouring)  
(Post holes prior to pouring)
5. **Under floor plumbing, with air test or water test on**
6. **Permanent electrical service**
7. **All rough in's; Building,**  
    **Electric,**  
    **H.V.A.C.**  
    **(with air test on) Plumbing**  
    (These need to be done at the same time.)  
    **Combine all rough in's for one trip.**
8. **Insulation with poly on walls and ceiling, before dry walling**
9. **Final inspection, when project is complete/before occupancy (Failure to call - \$50.00 fee)**
10. **Re-inspects are subject to additional charges**
11. **Misc. \_\_\_\_\_**
